8	Procedure for getting license	 An IT enabled platform will accept and electronically transfer applications to respective Competent Authorities as well as track & monitor status of the application. Under this system, Step 1: The applicant shall register through the Single Desk provision on the Industries Department Portal. Step 2: On registration, applicant will be given a unique ID and password for future reference. Step 3: The application form along with prescribed attachments shall be uploaded online. The application can be tracked online through a built-in system as per guidance available in the Single Desk portal. Step 4: On receipt of application form, the system will automatically forward it to the concerned Regional Office of APPCB. Step 5: All the Regional Officers of APPCB will be provided online access to the Portal through a secure user id and password, to process the applications forwarded to them. Step 6: The permission to be given by the Board is site specific. The staff of the Regional Office inspects the proposed site of the industry and prepares an inspection report. It is forwarded to the concerned competent authority. Step 7: The competent authority (Regional office/ Zonal Office/ Head Office, APPCB), shall prepares the application and communicate the
